Xosé Crisanto Gándara is PhD. in Philology and Music by the Universidade da Coruña. He is Professor of History of Music at the Conservatorio Superior de Música da Coruña, and has been Associate Professor in Musicology at the Universidad de La Rioja.

His doctoral dissertation, *Edición filológica y musical del manuscrito M-471 del Arquivo Distrital de Braga*, has been published at the Digital Repository of the Universidade da Coruña [<http://hdl.handle.net/2183/5668>], and has published many articles about Organology, Spanish Theatre of the XVII-XVIIIth centuries, Pop Music, Korean Music, as well as on local History.

He has given many talks and different international congresses and Symposiums, such as Michaelstein, Seoul, Reading, Évora, Oklahoma City, Lisboa, London, Pyongyang, Bucarest, Tiráspol, Blagoevgrad, Coimbra, Sofia, Yereván, Skopje, Minsk, Cetinje, etc., as well as the Congresses of the Spanish Musicological Society, Portuguese Musicological Society, International Musicological Society, and many others.

Besides, he has performed in several music acts, covering repertoires such as Classical, Jazz, Pop-rock, Folk, and Korean.
